Subject: Installation of Twisting and Spotting Belt in the City of Powell Aquatic Center

Explanation of Agenda Item:

The Park County School District #1 would like to install a twisting and spotting belt for use during PCSD#1 diving practice. They are requesting a permanent installation above the end of the diving board, attached to the roof joists.

There are several concerns which have been raised by the staff including:

- maintenance of the items & ensuring user safety
- the potential liability that the City may be taking on for an item not owned or used by the general public
- cost of installation & potential for upkeep cost
- permanent installation of an item not used by the City programming which includes ropes that will be attached to the walls & provide an attractive nuisance
- the potential for misuse of this item

The PAC staff is not knowledgeable about this particular piece of equipment and its usage, safety concerns, maintenance, etc.

What Action do you recommend the City Council take on this item?

We recommend that the City Council does not allow the permanent installation of an item which is not potentially beneficial to the community at large.
